The **National Theater of Northern Greece** continues for the third weekend, its program titled <u>"Greeks of the World"</u>, which includes a series featuring tributes and talks by Greek artists from different disciplines who excel abroad.

On **December 15 and 16, Daphnis Kokkinos,** a graduate of the Greek National School of Dance and the only Greek dancer at **Pina Bausch's Wuppertal Dance Theater,** will give a talk and a masterclass for professional dancers at the Vassiliko theater in Thessaloniki.

Daphnis Kokkinos was born in Heraklion, Crete. He began his studies in dance and theater at the Youth Theater of the Hellenic American Union, and received his diploma from the Greek National School of Dance.

In 1993 he joined the Pina Bausch's Wuppertal Dance Theater and in 2002 he became Pina Bausch's assistant until the legendary choreographer's death in 2009. His first solo work titled *Addio Addio Amore* is dedicated to her.

Daphne Kokkinos travels the world teaching dance workshops in Greece, Turkey, Korea, Italy, Sweden, Chile. His last work is the *Lamento* choreography with the National Opera School.
